

Water Body Forensic Recovery Bag

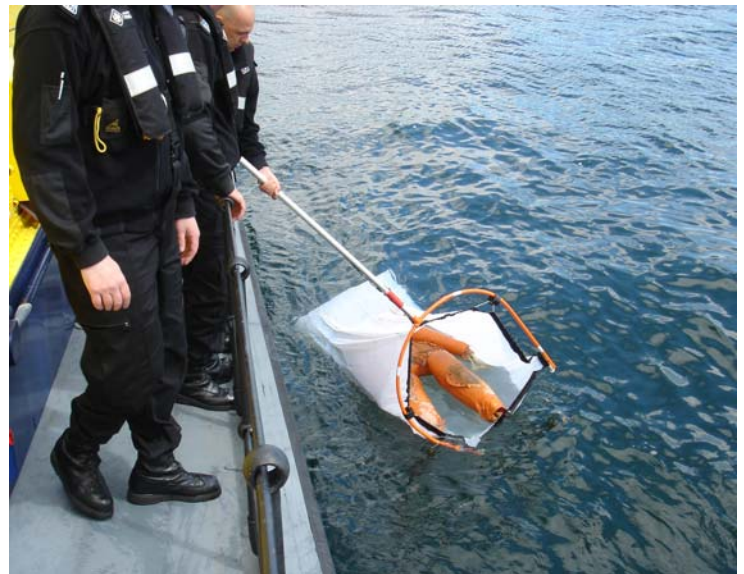
Simple and effective

Recovery of a body from the water is an unpleasant and sometimes difficult task, exacerbated by the problems of not knowing about possible contamination.

The Water Body Forensic Recovery Bag has been developed with the assistance of Strathclyde Police, Marine Policing Unit. The bag allows a body to be recovered quickly and easily, without experiencing some of the difficulties that can be faced when a body has been immersed for a long period of time. The mesh from which the bag is constructed allows water to disperse without the loss of evidence from the bag. The surface recovery bag is used in conjunction with our SB Rescue Sling, which is simple to operate, can be re-armed in 20-30 seconds and allows the body to be recovered and manoeuvred to a position where it can be brought ashore.

The underwater recovery bag allows divers to recover a body underwater with relative ease. Like the surface recovery bag, the construction permits the dispersal of water from the bag whilst retaining evidence for later examination.

Both types of bag are designed for one-off use
